Dear Friends in Christ,

It's a pleasure to introduce you to our work in Pakistan, a country that lies at the very heart of the unevangelized world. It ranks as the 2nd largest Islamic nation with an estimated 97% of the population being Muslim. Over 350 peoples and castes can be regarded as unevangelized. **However, a spiritual awakening is unfolding!** People from Muslim backgrounds are embracing Christianity, drawn by Christian literature, radio, television broadcasts, dreams, visions, and the influence of Pakistani Christians. These courageous converts, some with backgrounds as former militants, face significant challenges on their journey of faith. Existing Christian communities, predominantly comprising Muslim, Hindu, and lower-caste background believers, are often ill-equipped to guide and integrate these individuals effectively.

There is a **pressing need for evangelism and disciple making resources** to nurture and guide these brave souls. In response to this urgent need, I, Douglas Seaman, Sr. Pastor of Central Assembly of God in Cumberland, Maryland, and Founder of Cry of Deliverance (COD), work in collaboration with Pastor Asher Mansha of Christ Holiness Church Pakistan, to carry out the Great Commission in Pakistan. Together, we are seeing amazing results as thousands of people are coming to Christ and being discipled.

COD is a Maryland based 501c3 nonprofit organization on a mission to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ in difficult places, restricted nations, and to many unreached people. COD has partnerships in many unreached nations throughout the world. COD hosts preaching crusades, produces media content, books, study guides, and other Christian materials for the nations.

The opportunities addressed by this proposal include awakening people to the saving grace of Jesus Christ through evangelism/outreach and spiritual growth through transformational discipleship. The Opportunity in Karachi City

The ministry efforts outlined in this proposal are based in Karachi City, the largest city in Pakistan. Pastor Asher Mansha, serving as Sr. Pastor of Christ Holiness Church since 2002, is highly respected with a commendable reputation. He founded [ShineStar TV](#), broadcasting Christian programming in Pakistan and reaching 80 countries in the 10/40 window. Cry Of Deliverance financially supports this media ministry and is featured prominently in weekly programming, leading to **over 4,000 monthly calls** for prayer and resources. Pastor Asher, a bridge builder, respects local laws, customs, and the religious diversity of the region.



Cry of Deliverance/Christ Holiness Church Preaching Crusade

Our holistic strategy, outlined below, for reaching Pakistan for Christ includes continuing open-air preaching crusades, establishing a Bible College, launching a Christian school, translating Bible study guides, conducting village outreach, forming discipleship groups, providing vocational training, and offering tangible assistance to those facing persecution.

2024 Ministry Strategy & Impact

1. Discipleship Training for 250 Pastors (Gospel of Matthew, 1-year program)

Impact: Deepening pastors' understanding of the Gospel of Matthew, while enhancing pastoral knowledge, teaching skills, and improved leadership skills for effective ministry. This, in turn, will strengthen local congregations through well-equipped pastors.

2. School of Evangelism for 100 Evangelists (1-year program)

Impact: Equipped evangelists to disciple new believers effectively. Increased community engagement and positive transformation

3. Training for 500 Gospel workers (deployed at crusades and outreach events)

Impact: Better organized and coordinated outreach efforts. Our Gospel workers come from almost every denomination represented in the nation. They are united by the Holy Spirit and are committed to a New Testament message of freedom for the Believer through the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

4. Village Evangelism and Discipleship (1 village per month, 500 people per village)

Impact: Broadened reach and increased acceptance of the Gospel in rural communities. Many of the villages are comprised of families caught in modern-day slavery, having inherited a debt from their ancestors. They are then forced to work in the manufacturing of bricks. During village outreaches, we go beyond traditional activities, drilling water wells, distributing food, and providing toys for children. We instill the ethos for new congregations to independently carry out these initiatives, ensuring they become evangelistic churches right from their small beginnings.

5. Gospel of Luke Handouts (10,000 translated and printed)

Impact: Increased accessibility to the Gospel. Encouraged personal study and reflection. Facilitated conversations and engagement with non-believers. *Experienced church leaders in Pakistan have found that Muslims are more receptive initially to Luke.*

6. Audio Bibles on handheld devices (500 purchased and distributed)

Impact: Increased accessibility to the Word of God. Fostered personal spiritual growth. Enabled evangelists to share the Gospel through audio format.

7. Open Air Evangelistic Crusade (reaching 20,000 people for Christ, Karachi City, May 2024)

Impact: Direct exposure of a large population to the Gospel. Provides a foundation for ongoing discipleship efforts. Previous crusades have proven effective almost beyond description, with strong follow-up being a priority. Cry has conducted large, outdoor events in Karachi, Hyderabad, Mirpur Khas, Lahore, and numerous other cities across the nation.

8. Advantage Bible College

Impact: Train pastors, missionaries, and Christian leaders, fostering interfaith dialogue and promoting values of compassion, forgiveness, and love for one's neighbor. The curriculum will also prepare students for humanitarian work and community development.

9. Benny Public School

Impact: To provide high-quality education to 300 students annually, fostering responsible citizenship and harmonizing Christian faith with cultural and religious context. Tuition assistance and full sponsorship will be available.

10. Vocational Training Classes

Impact: To equip individuals with practical skills for employment and entrepreneurship, particularly beneficial in Karachi's competitive job market.

11. Residential Accommodations to Support Persecuted Christians

Impact: To provide short-term residential facilities for converts from Islam to Christianity, facing social and economic challenges. Safe and comfortable accommodations, legal assistance, counseling, and emotional support will be provided to facilitate social integration and community building. The goal is to help families transition to independent living and secure their future.

Coming Soon: J-Training Center

For some time, our team has been praying for the ability to house all that we are currently doing under one roof. We believe that God has given us the go ahead to begin fund-raising for this building, that will be called "The J-Training Center". The J-Training Center envisions a cultural shift centered around the teachings and values of Jesus in the lives of its students. By addressing the unique challenges faced by converts from Islam, the center aims to be a catalyst for positive change, fostering understanding, tolerance, and compassion in the diverse tapestry of Karachi City.

COD and Pastor Asher Mansha's vision for the J-Training Center in Karachi is a beacon of hope for persecuted and displaced Christians, providing education, vocational training, and a supportive community. This initiative represents a significant step toward awakening Pakistan to the transformative power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
